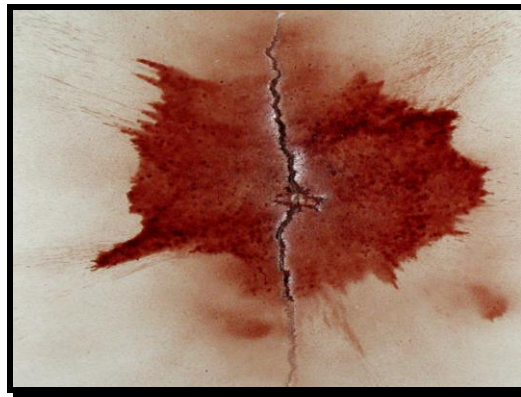

## Advanced Bloodstain Pattern Analysis Course:

This 40-hour advanced course is offered for students who have satisfactorily completed a Basic Bloodstain Pattern Analysis Course. The subject matter covered in this course will build upon information previously covered during your Basic Course. The course is divided into both lecture and laboratory sessions.

The objective of this course is to refresh, reinforce, and advance the students' knowledge in the field of bloodstain pattern analysis. A significant portion of this course will deal with the methods of utilizing bloodstain pattern analysis to reconstruct past events.

Students will have the opportunity to conduct examinations of bloodstain patterns where the "ground-truth is known" for each item and pattern being examined. In addition, students will re-examine adjudicated cases worked by the instructor which will provided them with the opportunity to apply their BPA knowledge and practice report writing skills.

Each student will be required to bring and present at **least one** case or research project directly related to bloodstain pattern analysis. Each student should have worked in a crime scene and/or laboratory setting where they have had an opportunity to evaluate bloodstain patterns prior to taking this course.
